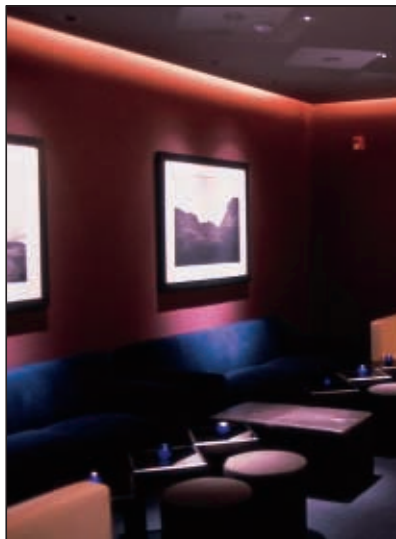

*Lighting designer uses GE ConstantColor® Precise™ MR16 lamps to create sophistication in Colorado private club.*

The challenge presented to lighting designer Robert Singer was to create the understated chic of a New York-style lounge—for the sophisticated clientele of 426, a private club in Aspen, Colorado.

“It was very important to create a warm, comfortable, ‘at-home’ feeling for the clientele, they expected it,” explained Singer, President of Robert Singer & Associates. “So, along with the interior designer, we created the needed ambience—employing a lighting design which gives space, height and drama to the 3,500 square-foot basement space.”

Singer chose **GE ConstantColor Precise MR16 lamps** for traffic pattern illumination in the space—as well as accent lighting in the bar area. “The combination of **20- and 50-watt lamps** offered the **variety of beam spreads we needed to make our design work. They enabled us to create the sophistication we wanted,**” the designer noted.

Singer’s plan also utilizes **32-watt GE T8 SPX fluorescent lamps with Starcoat™** to illuminate 426’s back bar and restroom areas.

“**GE ConstantColor Precise lamps delivered the crisp, white light we wanted, and provides 90 percent light output over the 6,000 hour rated lamp life,**” Singer said. “When combined with the **T8 SPX fluorescent lamp, with its warm incandescent look, a color temperature of 2800 and 86 CRI, we got the ambient quality we desired to make the project a success.**”
