Lighting designer selects GE lamps for Disney Florida hotel project.

Creating a design that blended art, science and conservation in a range of applications that included a dramatic atrium, guest rooms, public hallways and retail space at the Disney’s Wilderness Lodge near Orlando, Florida was the challenge.

Working with the Disney Development Company and the Urban Design Group, Chip Israel, principal – Lighting Alliance created “a themed and well integrated lighting design; one that could also meet state energy conservation criteria.”

Israel used a combination of 60- and 100-watt Halogen-IR™ lamps, plus 50-watt ConstantColor® Precise™ MR16s, in the retail areas; eight 50-watt ConstantColor® Precise™ MR16 lamps in each chandelier light the atrium. Public hallways are lit with 27-watt BIAX® compact fluorescent lamps, four per custom fixture, and two 39-watt BIAX® lamps light each guest bathroom vanity.

“We met all the design objectives and expect maintenance savings from longer GE lamp life; important with 7 million total bulbs on property to maintain,” the designer noted.
