Everyone at Eddy's Bakery, from the headquarters staff to production and maintenance workers, agreed that the facility's existing lighting was less than ideal for a production work environment. But in almost 20 years, no one had offered the Interstate Brand's Boise, Idaho company a cost-effective alternative.

“We continually asked our suppliers if they had a product that we could use to **replace the old high-pressure sodium lamps,**” explained Kevin Rieth, Chief Engineer of Maintenance. “But the answer was always ‘no.’ So we were forced to add supplemental fluorescent lighting over the discharge end of the ovens so we could monitor final product quality.”

Finally, Rieth's local GE Lighting representative told him there was a solution to his problem.

Reith evaluated and decided to install **72 new GE ChromaFit™ Multi-Vapor® lamps in the manufacturing plant, on a one-for-one basis, using the existing luminaires.** “Once the funds were approved by plant management and headquarters, we used our in-house staff to do the conversion project during weekends,” Rieth said.

**The GE ChromaFit™ Multi-Vapor® lamps have a CRI and lamp life equal to standard 400-watt metal halide lamps.** “Everyone is very happy with the new lighting,” added Reith. “We no longer need supplemental illumination to monitor product quality, and worker consensus is that **the new lights make for a better, friendlier work environment.**”
